ORDINANCE NO. 03-2009

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FIRE TERRITORY EQUIPMENT
REPLACEMENT FUND**

WHEREAS, the Town of Plainfield ("Town") is a civil taxing unit for purposes of civil Government Property Tax Controls in the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town has received notice from the State of Indiana, Department of Local Government Finance, Budget Division, that the Town will be receiving property taxes in the form of a certified levy for 2009 payable in 2010; and

WHEREAS, I.C. §36-8-19-8.5 requires that if the Town will be receiving property taxes in the form of a certified levy it must create a special fund to be known as the civil taxing unit's Fire Territory Equipment Replacement Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PLAINFIELD, INDIANA:

1. That there is hereby established a special fund to be known as the FIRE TERRITORY EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND for the Town of Plainfield.

2. That any property taxes received by the Town as part of the aforementioned certified levy shall be deposited and held in the FIRE TERRITORY EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND.

3. That the FIRE TERRITORY EQUIPEMNT REPLACEMENT FUND shall be maintained and operated in accordance with the requirements of I.C. §36-8-19-8.5.

4. This Ordinance is effective upon passage and any publication required by law.
