# TRAIL ETHICS

Users of the Plainfield Trail System must abide by all town park ordinances #10-2013

## TOP 10 TRAIL USERS ETHICS

1. Pets must be on leash and you must clean up after pets
2. Stay to the right to allow others to pass and allow oncoming users to go by
3. Bike speed may not exceed 15 miles per hour
4. Please pick up all trash and debris
5. Trails are only open dawn to dusk
6. Non authorized motorized vehicles are not allowed on trails
7. Be cautious around turns for other users
8. Users of the trail must stop at all road intersections. Vehicles have the right away
9. No signage/ graffiti/ or marking can be placed on the trail system without approval
10. Users must stay on the designated trail system. All other areas are off limits

# TRAIL MAINTENANCE 2016

In a goal to give trail access to all residents of the Town of Plainfield there will be scheduled construction to extend and add to the trail system.

During construction portions of the trail system may be taken offline. In these cases users are not permitted in the areas that will be designated "Trail Closed." Current construction plans for the Plainfield Trail System include:

- Extending the Vandalia Trail to the West
- Connecting the Vandalia Trail to the Del Webb Community
- Tree trimming and removal of dead trees along the Vandalia Trail
- Trail resurfacing
- Bicentennial Park
