SIGN UP FOR AUTOMATIC PAYMENT WITHDRAWAL

The Town of Plainfield Utility Billing Department has worked to establish a process to allow customers to sign up for automatic withdrawals directly from bank accounts.

To begin, customers will need a username and password for Citizen Self Service in order to sign up or to make any changes to your "American Clearing House" (ACH) information on the Town's website. Start by going to the website at townofplainfield.com.

Scroll to the blue "Pay Bills" icon in the middle of the home page.

Customers will then go to the "Utility Bill Payment" option on the Pay Bills page.

Click the "Log In" icon on the top, right-hand corner of the Plainfield Self Service page.

Log in using the same username and password used when paying or viewing your utility bill.

Click on "Utility Billing" located on the top right-hand side of the screen.

Click on "Accounts" on the right-hand side of the screen.

Choose "Automatic EFT Payments" on the right-hand side of the screen.

Customers will need to complete all of the fields listed; each field is required in order to process the ACH request. If you do not see your bank's routing number as an option, please call the Utility Billing Office at 317-837-0000. The Utility Billing Office will be able to add the routing number for you. Customers must select the "15th" for the preferred draft day, in order for your payment to be withdrawn on the 15th, due date, of each month. Once completed, click "Continue."

Finally, you will receive a confirmation page showing your request has successfully been submitted.

TOWN COUNCIL APPROVES PERFORMING AND FINE ARTS CENTER

The Plainfield Town Council granted approval to move forward with construction of the Plainfield Performing and Fine Arts Center in Downtown Plainfield.

The Performing and Fine Arts Center, which includes a 600-seat auditorium, will provide a new entertainment attraction in Downtown Plainfield. The Center is expected to be a regional attraction for local and touring performances. The Town Council entered a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Hendricks County Arts Groups to establish a partnership for the development of the center.

The Performing and Fine Arts Center is the second phase of a two-phase downtown construction project that started last October on the corner of Center and Main. A new Government Center is currently under construction adjacent to the existing municipal building and scheduled to be completed in the first quarter of 2022. The Performing and Fine Arts Center will then begin construction on the site where the current Municipal Building sits and will be connected to the new Government Center when completed. The new downtown complex will also house the Plainfield Chamber of Commerce office and a community room space.
