MAIN STREET CROSSWALK STAMPING

By the publication of this newsletter, you may have already witnessed street crews beginning work on Main Street to install decorative crosswalk designs at various downtown locations. These visual enhancements serve to create a unique feel for both drivers and pedestrians by highlighting the walkable routes through Downtown Plainfield, particularly along the Main Street corridor. Introducing contrasting visual elements can improve safety as they provide better indication of places where different types of users use the street, whether that be for walking or bicycling.

Temporary lane restrictions will be necessary along Main St. to complete this work, while some side streets may be completely closed for 1-2 days to finish those specific areas. The entire project is expected to last approximately 3 weeks and be finished around the middle of October.

The installation of these decorative designs is an interesting process, so don't hesitate to make a special trip downtown to check out all the activity and stop by our local businesses who always appreciate your support!
