**RESOLUTION TO OPT BACK IN TO OPIOIDS SETTLEMENT
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 4-6-15-2**

WHEREAS, the Town of Plainfield has been actively engaged in pursuing damages caused by the manufacture, sale, and distribution of opioids through outside counsel in multidistrict litigation; and

WHEREAS, recent legislation amending Indiana Code 4-6-15 has been adopted by the Indiana legislature and signed into law by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Plainfield, Indiana, after due consideration of said legislation, has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens to opt back in to the opioids' settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Plainfield, Indiana that the Town of Plainfield, Indiana, having considered whether to elect to opt back in to the opioids settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2, hereby resolves that the Town of Plainfield now exercises its election to opt back in to the opioid settlements, and orders its duly authorized agent to submit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Indiana Attorney General by July 15, 2022.
