## AUTOMATED UTILITY BILLING SYSTEM UPDATE

On April 11, 2022, the Town of Plainfield will be upgrading the utility billing system to provide an enhanced experience and new features. With this update, one of the security changes will require a upgrade to the login process, forcing customers to create a new login.

On customers' first sign-in after April 11, 2022, customers will need to select one of the following in creating their account: Facebook, Microsoft, Apple, Google, or a new Tyler ID (Citizen Self Service) account.

If customers use the same e-mail address for the new log-in that was previously used, account linking will be done for you by the new system.

### HEAVY TRASH DAYS

The Plainfield Spring Heavy Trash Days have been set! The Plainfield Department of Public Works will be hosting Heavy Trash Days on **Saturday April 23rd and April 30th, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.** Plainfield residents may bring acceptable heavy trash items to the designated dumpsters at the Town garage located at 986 S. Center Street. Items accepted include just about everything except hazardous waste, tires, building materials, or yard waste. This also includes furniture, although residents who bring mattresses will have to handle getting the mattresses out of their vehicle and into the dumpster on their own. For sanitary reasons, DPW staff will not handle such items. Residents should remove gas and oil from mowers and leaf blowers. Ray's Document Destruction will also be onsite once again.

### COMMUNITY GARDENS

The Plainfield Parks Department received some positive feedback following last year's harvest season at the Community Gardens. Center Community Church, where the Community Gardens are located, reached out to inform that growing efforts were successful in delivering fresh produce to Plainfield and other nearby communities. In fact, the church was able to grow and donate 78 crates of vegetables to local food pantries last year!
