WHO PLOWS MY ROADS?

It's that time of the year again. You will begin seeing snow plows on roads as inclement weather approaches our area. This is a good reminder to know who exactly maintains and plows each road within Town, specifically yours!

Plainfield DPW is responsible for main and side streets within Town limits. For example: Ronald Reagan Parkway, Quaker Boulevard, Perry Road and Stafford Road.

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) is responsible for numbered state roads and highways. For example: U.S. 40 and I-70.

Hendricks County Highway Department is responsible for county roads outside of incorporated areas. For example: S. C.R. 600 E. and S. C.R. 625 E.

Private contractors are responsible for various roadways and driveways. For example: Private driveways, residential communities and parking lots.

No matter who is on the road, this is a good reminder to follow these tips:

- Don't crowd the plow.
- Plows travel slower than other vehicles.
- Reduce your speed and try to stay at least 100 feet away from all plows.
- Don't pass snowplow vehicles while they're plowing.

Visibility is already limited and plow drivers want to avoid any and all dangerous situations.

- Our social media platforms are good ways to learn about everything happening within the Town. Residents may also call Town Hall at 317-839-2561 for assistance.
- The Plainfield Post is a supplement to your utility bill, which customers receive around the 1st of the every month.
