DOWNTOWN UPDATES: GOVERNMENT CENTER + PARKING

As of Monday, May 23rd, the Town of Plainfield is conducting business out of the new Government Center located on the corner of Main and Mill Streets and the former Municipal Building is permanently closed. The payment drop off box is now located in front of the front door, located on the drive off of Mill Street. It is important to note, the Government Center will keep the same address: 206 West Main Street, Plainfield, Indiana.

In addition to the opening of the new Government Center, the Plainfield Parking Structure has an exciting update. The parking structure is now FREE the first 2 hours. When the structure opened in January of 2021, the rates began at \$2 after just one hour of free parking. The Plainfield Community Development Corporation (PCDC) and the Town of Plainfield have worked diligently to adjust the price structure to better serve the community and the businesses in the Downtown District. SCOPING AND ALIGNMENT STUDY PUBLIC INPUT SESSIONS

The Town of Plainfield will hold a Public Information Meeting on Thursday, June 2, 2022 regarding a Scoping and Alignment Study being developed as a result of SR 267 getting relinquished by INDOT to become Quaker Boulevard. **The meeting will be held at Plainfield High School (One Red Pride Drive, Plainfield, IN) and will have two sessions: 10:30 am - 1:00 pm and 4:30 pm – 7:00 pm.** Each session will consist of a short presentation to begin 30 minutes after the doors open, followed by an informal open house. The open house sessions will provide the public an opportunity to view alignment study exhibits and interact with the study team.

The public is welcome to arrive at any time during the sessions.

The Town of Plainfield's Scoping and Alignment Study focuses on the southern area of Plainfield, north and south of I-70. The purpose of this public information meeting is to inform and obtain the public's views regarding the potential future projects and alternatives being analyzed in this study.

INDOT ANNOUNCES SOUTH CENTER STREET CLOSURE

The Indiana Department of Transportation announced S. Center St. (Old S.R. 267) will close on or after Wednesday, June 1 (originally scheduled for June 6) between Hadley Rd. and Black Rock Rd. for reconstruction work on the bridge over I-70.

This project was awarded to Reith Riley Construction for \$1.4 million. It's expected to last through the end of October, weather permitting.
