

## RAY'S TRASH SERVICE PILOTING NEW RECYCLING & TRASH PROGRAM FOR THURSDAY ROUTE

A new pilot program between the Town of Plainfield and Ray's Trash is set to roll out in November. This pilot program is limited to residents in the Glen Haven, Glen Haven West, Bridlewood, Center Ridges neighborhoods (just to name a few) who receive Thursday trash pick-up. Expansion of this program may happen sometime in the future as we continue to monitor customer response.

This new program is set to begin the first week of November. All residents on the Thursday pickup route will be receiving 96 gallon recycling bins with yellow lids around the first of November. To prepare for the new pilot program, all recyclables should be loose in the container. Do NOT bag recyclables. Each home will also receive a new 96 gallon container with a black lid for bagged trash. If you have an old trash container you would like to dispose of, we will designate a week (TBD) and you can drop it off at the Plainfield Department of Public Works.

The first date set to pickup trash and recycling from the new containers is **Thursday, November 3rd**. Following this date, trash will be picked up every Thursday, and recycling pickup will be recurring on alternating Thursdays. This new process will allow for larger amounts of recyclable contents (and larger boxes) to be properly disposed of, ultimately keeping more waste out of landfills.

With this new style of bins, trucks will be able to lift and empty the contents with hydraulic arms. This means that each Ray's truck will no longer require a second service working to ride along to individually pick up and empty each recycling bin. This will lead to more efficient pickup schedules for Ray's and ultimately some significant cost-savings.
