## FALL LEAF PICKUP

The 2022 Fall Leaf Season Pickup will begin on Monday, October 24th and continue through Friday, December 2nd, weather-permitting. There will not be leaf pickup Thursday and Friday, November 24th and 25th due to the Thanksgiving holiday. The schedule will remain the same as the past few years.

**Monday Route:** North of Main Street (US 40) West of Avon Avenue, inside Plainfield corporate limits

**Tuesday Route:** North of Main Street (US 40), East of Avon Avenue, inside Plainfield corporate limits

**Wednesday Route:** South of Main Street (US 40), East of S Mill Street, North of Stafford Road, inside Plainfield corporate limits

**Thursday Route:** East of S Center Street, North of Reeves Road, South of Stafford, inside Plainfield corporate limits

**Friday Route:** South of Main Street (US 40), West of White Lick Creek, plus everything South of Reeves Road, inside Plainfield corporate limits

### The Town advises the following guidelines:

- Have leaves at the pickup site by 7 a.m.
- Have only leaves in the pile for pickup, or they will not be picked up. (Trash, debris, sticks, or limbs will NOT be picked up as they damage the vacuums.)
- Rake to the area between the sidewalk and curb.
- Leaf pile should be no more than 6 feet in width.
- Do NOT park vehicles near the pickup site.

## RAYS TRASH SERVICE UPDATE

Waste Management recently acquired the Town's trash provider, Ray's Trash Service.

The Town of Plainfield would like to let residents know their **trash service and trash pick-up days have not changed and will remain the same at this time.**

As far as the recently announce Trash and Recycling Pilot Program, the Town is going to postpone the program. The Trash and Recycling Pilot Program will not begin in November as previously communicated, as Waste Management and the Town of Plainfield will meet to discuss additional bin options and sizes before moving forward with such a program.

## HEAVY TRASH DAY ON OCTOBER 15th

The Plainfield Department of Public Works will be hosting a Heavy Trash Day on **Saturday October 15th, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.** Plainfield residents may bring acceptable heavy trash items to the designated dumpsters at the Town garage located at 986 S. Center Street. Items accepted include just about everything except hazardous waste, tires, building materials, or yard waste. This also includes furniture, although residents who bring mattresses will have to handle getting the mattresses out of their vehicle and into the dumpster on their own. For sanitary reasons, DPW staff will not handle such items. Residents should remove gas and oil from mowers and leaf blowers. Ray's Document Destruction will also be onsite once again.
