AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PLAINFIELD FIRE DEPARTMENT
BENEFCIENT FUND AND FOR ITS ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, the Plainfield Fire Department occasionally receives money in the form of gifts, contributions, donations, and bequests; and

WHEREAS, the Plainfield Town Council, deems it to be in the best interest of the Town of Plainfield and the Plainfield Fire Department to establish a system to receive, hold and disburse such monies; and


WHEREAS, the Plainfield Town Council has determined that the proper way to receive, hold and disburse such monies is to create a separate fund for such monies under the supervision of the Plainfield Fire Chief and the Plainfield Town Council:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Plainfield Town Council, Plainfield, Indiana, as follows:

1. Creation of Fund. There is hereby created and established a specific fund to be known as the "Plainfield Fire Department Beneficent Fund" into which all monies and proceeds received in the form of gifts, contributions, donations and bequests to the Plainfield Fire Department shall be deposited.
2. Responsibility for Fund. The Fire Chief of the Plainfield Fire Department shall be responsible for receiving all funds to be deposited in such account and shall keep records as to the amounts received, the manner of their receipt, any disbursements and a current balance in such fund at all times.
3. Disbursement of Funds. Any use of any portion of said funds shall be initiated by a request through the Fire Chief of the Plainfield Fire Department who shall then make a recommendation either to approve or not approve such a request to the Plainfield Town Council. The Town Council shall then, in its sole discretion, either approve or not approve a disbursement of the funds for the purpose requested, and further, if the Town Council approves the disbursement it shall determine the amount of funds to be distributed by the Fire Chief.
4. Use of Funds. The purposes for the use of such funds and the amount authorized shall be for any lawful purpose at the sole discretion of the Plainfield Fire Chief and Plainfield Town Council.






