ORDINANCE NO. 19-2002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF PLAINFIELD FOR THE PURPOSE
OF REDISTRICTING THE TOWN OF PLAINFIELD,
HENDRICKS COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town of Plainfield has been divided into districts for the purpose of conducting elections of Town officers, first by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Hendricks when the Town was incorporated, and subsequently by the legislative body of the Town;

WHEREAS, State law (Indiana Code 36-5-1-10.1 and 36-5-2-4.1(b)) sets forth the following requirements for the creation of Town Council districts by the Town legislative body;

- (1) The districts must be composed of contiguous territory;
- (2) The districts must be reasonably compact;
- (3) The districts must contain, as nearly as is possible, equal population; and
- (4) The boundary of a Town Council district may cross a precinct boundary line only if all members of the Town Council are to be elected at large by the voters of the whole Town;

WHEREAS, the Town Council is the legislative body of the Town of Plainfield by virtue of state law (Indiana Code 36-5-2-2);

WHEREAS, State law (Indiana Code 36-5-2-4.1(g)) requires that the legislative body of the Town make a new division of the Town into districts during 2002 if the Town wishes to use districts for the purpose of conducting Town elections after that date;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has, at a public meeting of the Council, provided an opportunity for all members of the Council and voters of the Town to comment and make suggestions concerning the division of the Town into districts under this Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that the division of the Town into districts for the purpose of conducting elections of Town officers would be desirable and beneficial for the voters of the Town and for the convenient administration of Town government;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has examined the district boundaries set forth in this Ordinance and finds that the districts:

- (1) are composed of contiguous territory;
- (2) are reasonably compact;
- (3) contain, as nearly as is possible, equal population; and
- (4) cross precinct boundary lines in the manner permitted under Indiana Code 36-5-2-4.1 (b) since all members of the Town Council are to be elected at large by the voters of the whole Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PLAINFIELD, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. As used in this Ordinance:

- (1) "Council" refers to the Town Council of the Town of Plainfield.
- (2) "Town" refers to the Town of Plainfield.

SECTION 2. The Council consists of five (5) members.

SECTION 3. The members of the Council shall be elected at large by the voters of the whole Town, in accordance with I.C. 36-5-2-5.

SECTION 4. The Town Council divides the Town into five (5) districts for the purpose of conducting elections of Town officers. Said districts are more particularly described and attached hereto and made a part hereof as Attachment A.

SECTION 5. If any part of the Town is not included in one (1) of the districts established by this Ordinance, that territory is included within the district that:

- (1) is contiguous to that territory; and
- (2) contains the smallest population (as "population" is defined in Indiana Code 1-1-4-5).

SECTION 6. If any part of the Town is included in more than one (1) of the districts established by this Ordinance, that territory is included within the district that:

- (1) is one (1) of the districts in which the territory is described in this Ordinance;
- (2) is contiguous to that territory; and
- (3) contains the smallest population (as "population" is defined in Indiana Code 1-1-4.5).

SECTION 7. The Council adopts a map depicting the districts established under this Ordinance, and incorporates the map by reference into this Ordinance. Two (2) copies of this map are on file in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer for public inspection as required by Indiana 36-1-5-4. If a conflict exists between the districts as depicted on the map and as described in this Ordinance, the description in this Ordinance prevails.


SECTION 8. The Clerk-Treasurer of the Town shall forward a signed copy of this Ordinance to the Circuit Court Clerk of Hendricks County and shall request the Clerk to include the copy of this Ordinance in the records of the Hendricks County Election Board.

SECTION 9. All prior ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION 10. As provided by Indiana Code 36-5-2-10, this Ordinance takes effect when signed by the President of the Town Council as Town Executive.

Attachment "A"

District No. 1:

That part of the Town of Plainfield located as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Center Street and Main Street; thence northerly along Center Street to the north Corporate Limits and Holz knecht Estates; thence along Holz knecht Estates to the abandoned railroad; thence northeasterly along the abandoned railroad to Northfield Woods; thence along Northfield Woods and the Corporate Limits northerly, westerly and easterly to Carr Road; thence northerly along Carr Road to Township Line Road; thence westerly along Township Line Road to a point; thence along the Corporate Limits and the Crowe annexation to State Road 267; thence northerly along State Road 267 to the south line of Hidden Valley Estates; thence easterly along the northern line of the Corporate Limits and along the northerly and easterly lines of Willimsburg North, Colony Lake, Plainfield Christian Church, and Coventry Ridge to Township Line Road; thence westerly along Township Line Road to Dan Jones Road; thence southerly along Dan Jones Road to the abandoned railroad; thence northeasterly along the abandoned railroad to County Road 900 East; thence northerly along County Road 900 East to the northwest corner of Westmere Subdivision and its intersection with County Road 900 East; thence easterly and northerly along Westmere Subdivision to County Road 200 South; thence easterly along County Road 200 South and the Corporate Limits to a point; thence southerly along a line to the southwest corner of Medallion Meadows; thence easterly along the south line of Medallion Meadows to the southeast corner of Lot 39; thence northerly to Six Points Drive North Lane; thence easterly along Six Points Drive North Lane to County Road 1050 East; thence easterly and northerly along the Corporate Limits to the west line of Hobbs Nursery; thence northerly along the west line of Hobbs Nursery to County Road 200 South; thence easterly along County Road 200 South to a point; thence northwesterly along the Corporate Limits to County Road 1050 East; thence northerly along County Road 1050 East to a point; thence easterly along the Corporate Limits to Raceway Road and the Hendricks / Marion County Line; thence southerly along the Corporate Limits and Raceway Road to the abandoned railroad; thence southwestly along the abandoned railroad to County Road 1050 East; thence southerly along County Road 1050 East to the north line of Section 32, Township 15 North, Range 2 East; thence westerly along the section line to South Perry Road; thence northerly along South Perry Road to Main Street; thence southwestly along Main Street to the Center Street intersection and the POINT OF BEGINNING, except any parcel of land within the above described limits which has not been incorporated within the limits of the Town of Plainfield.

District No. 2:

That part of the Town of Plainfield located as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Center Street and Main Street; thence northeasterly along Main Street to Vine Street; thence southeasterly along Vine Street to South Street; thence northeasterly along South Street to East Street; thence southerly along East Street to Stafford Road; thence easterly along Stafford Road to Gary Drive; thence southerly along Gary Drive, Rogers Drive and Ridgewood Drive to Stanley Road; thence westerly along Stanley Road to Center Street; thence northwesterly along Center Street to County Road 700 East; thence southwestwesterly along County Road 700 East to White Lick Creek; thence northeasterly along White Lick Creek to the east/west centerline of Section 34, Township 15 North, Range 1 East; thence westerly along said centerline to Moon Road (County Road 600 East); thence northerly along Moon Road (County Road 600 East) to Main Street; thence southwestwesterly along Main Street to the Corporate Limits; thence northerly along the Corporate Limits to the abandoned railroad; thence southwestwesterly along the abandoned railroad to the southwest corner of the Saratoga Development; thence northerly and westerly along the Saratoga Development to County Road 350 South; thence along County Road 350 South, the Saratoga Development and Corporate Limits to the southwest corner of Rockingham; thence along Rockingham, Nottinghill and the Oles annexation to County Road 350 South; thence easterly along County Road 350 South to the northeast corner of the Homestead at Saratoga; thence along the northerly and easterly lines of Homestead at Saratoga to the west line of Willow Pointe; thence northerly and easterly along Willow Pointe, Vestal Road and Pike Lane to Ridgeline Estates; thence northerly and easterly along Ridgeline Estates to Center Street; thence southerly along Center Street to the Main Street intersection and the POINT OF BEGINNING, except any parcel of land within the above described limits which has not been incorporated within the limits of the Town of Plainfield.

District No. 3:

That part of the Town of Plainfield located as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) and Stanley Road; thence southerly along State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) to Hadley Road; thence easterly along Hadley Road to County Road 875 East; thence southerly along County Road 875 East to County Road 700 South; thence westerly along the Corporate Limits and County Road 700 South to a point; thence northerly along the Corporate Limits to Interstate 70; thence southwesterly along Interstate 70 to Center Street; thence northerly along Center Street and the North American Islamic Center property to Hadley Road; thence westerly along Hadley Road and the Corporate Limits to the southwest corner of Glen Haven West; thence northerly along the west line of Glen Haven West to the northwest corner of Glen Haven West; thence northerly and westerly along the State of Indiana annexation and the Corporate Limits to Moon Road (County Road 600 East); thence northerly on Moon Road (County Road 600 East) to the south line of Mongan's Farm/Damon Jones annexation; thence westerly and northerly along the Corporate Limits and the Mongan's Farm/Damon Jones annexation to Main Street; thence northeasterly along Main Street to Moon Road (County Road 600 East); thence southerly along Moon Road (County Road 600 East) to the east/west centerline of Section 34, Township 15 North, Range 1 East; thence easterly along said centerline to White Lick Creek; thence southeasterly along White Lick Creek to County Road 700 East; thence northeasterly along County Road 700 East to Center Street; thence southeasterly along Center Street to Stanley Road; thence easterly along Stanley Road to the State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) intersection and the POINT OF BEGINNING, except any parcel of land within the above described limits which has not been incorporated within the limits of the Town of Plainfield.

District No. 4:

That part of the Town of Plainfield located as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) and Stanley Road; thence westerly along Stanley Road to Ridgewood Drive; thence northerly along Ridgewood Drive, Rogers Drive, Gary Drive, and Simmons Street to Oliver Drive; thence easterly along Oliver Drive to Elm Street; thence northerly along Elm Street to Butler Drive; thence easterly along Butler Drive and its extension to State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard); thence southerly along State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) to Stafford Road; thence easterly along Stafford Road to the intersection of Stafford Road and the Hendricks / Marion County Line; thence southerly along the Hendricks / Marion County Line to a point; thence westerly along the Corporate Limits to County Road 1075 East; thence northerly along County Road 1075 East to County Road 600 South; thence westerly along County Road 600 South to a point; thence along the Corporate Limits southerly and easterly to the East Fork of White Lick Creek; thence along the East Fork of White Lick Creek to County Road 700 South; thence westerly along County Road 700 South to County Road 875 East; thence northerly along County Road 875 East to Hadley Road; thence westerly along Hadley Road to State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard); thence northerly along State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) to the Stanley Road intersection and the POINT OF BEGINNING, except any parcel of land within the above described limits which has not been incorporated within the limits of the Town of Plainfield.

District No. 5:

That part of the Town of Plainfield located as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) and Stafford Road; thence northerly along State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) to a point; thence westerly and southerly along Butler Drive to Elm Street; thence southerly along Elm Street to Oliver Drive; thence westerly along Oliver Drive to Simmons Street; thence along Simmons Street to Stafford Road; thence westerly along Stafford Road to East Street; thence northerly along East Street to South Street; thence southwestly along South Street to Vine Street; thence northwestly along Vine Street to Main Street; thence northeasterly along Main Street to South Perry Road; thence southerly along South Perry Road to the south line of Section 30, Township 15 North, Range 2 East; thence easterly along the section line to County Road 1050 East; thence southerly to the south line of Peaceful Acres; thence easterly along the south line of Peaceful Acres to the Hendricks / Marion County Line; thence southerly along the Hendricks / Marion County Line to Stafford Road; thence westerly along Stafford Road to the State Road 267 (Quaker Boulevard) intersection and the POINT OF BEGINNING, except any parcel of land within the above described limits which has not been incorporated within the limits of the Town of Plainfield.
