

ORDINANCE NO. 26-2006

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING ENFORCEMENT ON CAMBRIDGE WAY,
MANCHESTER DRIVE, CLARK'S CREEK ROAD AND HARTFORD AVENUE IN THE
TOWN OF PLAINFIELD, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Plainfield, Hendricks County, Indiana ("Town Council") has determined that it is necessary to establish no parking on certain streets in the Town of Plainfield; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has the authority under I.C. §9-21-5-11 as well as Acts 1905 Chapter 129 and amendments thereto, to establish time limits on public streets within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Plainfield:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND ORDAINED that:

SECTION 1. There shall be NO PARKING on Clarks Creek Road South of Hadley Road, Cambridge Way Drive, Hartford Avenue and Manchester Drive.

SECTION 2. The Superintendent of Public Works is authorized by the Plainfield Town Council to post NO PARKING signs for specified streets as follows:

- a. Clark's Creek Road south of Hadley Road (CR 600 South)
- b. Cambridge Way Drive
- c. Hartford Avenue
- d. Manchester Drive

SECTION 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a Town Ordinance violation for which a citation to a person who violates this Ordinance may be issued by the Plainfield Metropolitan Police Department.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be enforced through Town Ordinance 13-2005 (Parking Enforcement).

SECTION 5. For purposes of public safety, the Plainfield Police Chief in consultation with the Plainfield Town Engineer, may designate specific areas of streets described in Section 2 of this Ordinance for placement of NO PARKING-VEHICLES WILL BE TOWED signage.

SECTION 6. The owner of any vehicle whose vehicle is towed for violating the NO PARKING-VEHICLES WILL BE TOWED provisions of this Ordinance shall be responsible for paying all towing charges in addition to any fees and costs imposed for violating the Ordinance.

SECTION 7. Any person who violates the Ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.

SECTION 8. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be judged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any sections, provisions or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

SAID ORDINANCE is hereby passed and adopted this 28TH day of August, 2006.
