

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-2007**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR CREEKSIDE ESTATES IN  
THE TOWN OF PLAINFIELD, INDIANA**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Plainfield, Indiana, that:

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Plainfield of Hendricks County, Indiana deem it appropriate to establish or increase in the speed limit on certain streets in the Town of Plainfield; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Plainfield of Hendricks County, Indiana deem it appropriate to establish no parking on certain streets in the Town of Plainfield; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Plainfield of Hendricks County, Indiana have the authority under I.C. 9-21-5-11 as well as Acts 1905 Chapter 129 and amendments thereto, to establish speed limits and to establish time limits on public streets within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Plainfield:

NOW THEREFORE, by the powers vested in the Town Council of the Town of Plainfield, Hendricks County, Indiana, it is hereby ORDERED AND ORDAINED that:

**SECTION 1.** In accordance with I.C. 9-21-5-11 the Town of Plainfield may establish increased speed limits for specific streets where determined to be appropriate.

**SECTION 2.** Speed limits to be changed as noted for the following streets:

1. Creekside Lane: Establish Speed Limit at twenty-five (25) miles per hour (mph).
2. Creekside Court: Establish Speed Limit at twenty-five (25) miles per hour (mph).
3. Corey Lane: Establish Speed Limit at twenty-five (25) miles per hour (mph).

4. Chad Court: Establish Speed Limit at twenty-five (25) miles per hour (mph).

**SECTION 4.** The Superintendent of Public Works is authorized by the Plainfield Town Council to post traffic control signs notifying the traveling public of the maximum speed limits established as well as to post no parking signs for the specified street.

**SECTION 5.** An Officer of the Plainfield Police Department may issue a Town Ordinance violation citation to a person who violates this ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall be enforced through Town of Plainfield Ordinance 39-2005: Exceeding the Posted Speed Limit.

**SECTION 7.** If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be judged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any sections, provisions or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

SAID ORDINANCE is hereby passed and adopted this 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 2007.




